- ♦ Pileated Woodpeckers - back woods
- ♦ White-Breasted Nuthatch - feeders
- ♦ American Goldfinch - feeders
- ♦ American Robin - around feeders and shop
- ♦ Rufous-Sided Towhee - ground near feeders
- ♦ Cardinal - feeders
- ♦ Rose-Breasted Grosbeak - feeders
- ♦ Scarlet Tanager - woods and bathing in creek
- ♦ Mockingbird - tops of trees singing
- ♦ Carolina Chickadee - feeders
- ♦ Dark-Eyed Junco - feeders
- ♦ Tufted Titmouse - feeders
- ♦ Belted Kingfisher - front creek
- ♦ Blue Jay - feeders
- ♦ Indigo Bunting - ground near feeders
- ♦ Eastern Blue Bird - field and front yard
- ♦ Eastern Phoebe - above front porch and yard
- ♦ Ruby-Throated Hummingbird – feeders on porches
- ♦ Carolina Wren
- ♦ Brown Thrasher - around the edge of woods

- ♦ Brown-Headed Cowbird – feeders
- ♦ Chipping Sparrow - feeders
- ♦ Acadian & Great Crested Flycatchers – yard
- ♦ White-Crown Sparrow - ground near feeders
- ♦ White-Throat Sparrows
- ♦ Song Sparrow-Feeders
- ♦ Hooded and Kentucky Warblers - woods
- ♦ Yellow Billed Cuckoo - woods
- ♦ Various hawks seen in field across creek
- ♦ Barn Swallow – front yard & field
